OBJECTS GOALS AND CANDIDATES

Università degli Studi di Milano (Italy) and **Universidade Nova de Lisboa** (Portugal) jointly organize the 2nd edition of the Summer School on Transnational Dispute Resolution, which will take place from 1 to 16 September 2014 in the beautiful settings of Palazzo Feltrinelli at Gargnano (Brescia), on the shores of Lake Garda and in the enchanting city of Lisbon.

The Summer School is structured in three different modules on **Mediation**, **International Commercial Arbitration** and **Transnational Litigation** respectively. The first and the second modules will be held in Gargnano and the third one in Lisbon. The Summer School is open to undergraduates and/or postgraduates and/or lawyers who want to improve their knowledge of the theory and practice of transnational disputes resolution, also in view of a possible career in that field of law.




LOCATIONS
