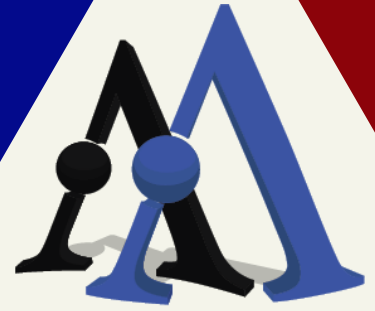
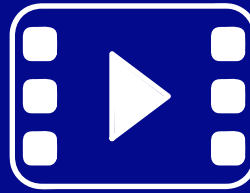

## **Virtual Meeting of Young Scholars e-ASADIP 2020**

### **Call for research posters and videos**

Every year the American Association of Private International Law (ASADIP) opens a call for posters, videos and research papers from young scholars in the field of Private International Law.

This year, due to the particular circumstances resulting from the Covid-19 global crisis, ASADIP invites to the Virtual Meeting of Young Scholars and opens the Call for the submission of research posters and videos for the e-ASADIP 2020.

**I. Participants:** The call is aimed at advanced Law students, at UG or PG level, graduates in Law, Ph.D. students and young scholars and teachers.

#### **II. The event is organised in the following categories:**

- a) Advanced UG Law students and Law graduates (up to 30 years of age)
- b) PG (Masters and Ph.D) students (up to 35 years of age)
- c) Young scholars and teachers (up to 35 years of age)

Submissions can be individual or collective. If collective the group can be made up of a maximum of three (3) participants.

Collective works bringing together participants in different categories (see above, a, b, c) are inadmissible.

**III. Research directors:** The research outputs (posters or videos) must have been supervised by a Research Director, who must be a Member of ASADIP. In the case of scholarship holders who have a Director that is not a Member of ASADIP, to participate in this call they need to provide the endorsement of a co-Director of Research who must be a Member of ASADIP.

**IV.** Submissions should focus on issues relevant to Private International Law in the Americas, or to private international law issues in a specific country in the Americas.

#### **V. Themes:**

- a) Global Governance, Human Rights and Private International Law
- b) Gender and Private International Law
- c) Migration and Private International Law
- d) Private international law for the protection of families and the rights of children
- e) International commercial law
- f) Private international law and corporate social responsibility
- g) International civil procedure law
- h) Arbitration and foreign investment
- i) Private international law and modern technologies
- j) Research and teaching methodologies in private international law

#### **VI. Submission format:**



- a) Poster: the poster must be submitted in the [ppt template](#) made available for this purpose by ASADIP. The format and size provided cannot be altered. Images and/or graphics may be included in addition to the text.
- b) Video: is intended to present orally the research output shown in the poster and it must be recorded in one of the permitted languages in the event. The maximum time-length of the video cannot exceed 2 minutes. The name of the participant/s, their University of origin, their country and the title of the work presented should be mentioned in the video recording and on the file name, and the poster must be projected in the recording, simultaneously with the oral presentation.

**VII. Languages:** posters and videos in Spanish, Portuguese and English will be admissible.

**VIII. Pre-registration, summary and CV:** Those who wish to participate must complete the relevant [registration form](#) before November 6, 2020, indicating:

- a) personal data of each participant, of the Research director and of the co-director if applicable.
- b) a summary proposal of the work to be presented that does not exceed 600 words
- c) a curriculum vitae of each participant that does not exceed 100 words

Participation in this event is free of charge and it is not required that the participant authors are members of ASADIP.

**IX. Selected proposals:** The ASADIP Council will announce on 13 November 2020 the proposals selected for the preparation of the corresponding poster and video.

**X. Rules for sending the posters and videos:** the poster and video should be sent to the e-mail address: [jovenesasadip@gmail.com](mailto:jovenesasadip@gmail.com), indicating in the email "subject" the following information: CALL eASADIP 2020, home country of the author/s and surname/s of the author/s.

**XI. Deadline for submission of posters and videos:** December 6, 2020

**XII. Notification of the videos and posters to be presented at the Virtual Meeting of Young Scholars of the e-ASADIP 2020:** The Council of ASADIP will notify on 14 December 2020 the list of posters and videos selected for presentation at the Virtual Meeting of Young Scholars of the e-ASADIP 2020.

**XII. Presentation, evaluation, and awards:** The posters and videos that have been selected by the ASADIP Council will be shown at the "Virtual Meeting of Young Researchers of the e-ASADIP 2020", via Zoom on December 17, 2020.

Said works will be evaluated by a Committee, which will be made up of Members of ASADIP from various countries (elected by the ASADIP Council).

The authors of the posters and videos must connect via Zoom and be available to the Committee so that it can ask any questions or concerns in relation to the work presented during the Zoom meeting.

During the Virtual Meeting, the members of the Committee will only be able to formulate questions or clarification to the authors.



The Committee will consider the posters and videos presented in the Virtual Meeting and will choose, by a vote, the most outstanding work of each category, whose author/s will receive an Honoris mention certificate.

If deemed necessary, the Committee may award more than one mention for each category. In the Virtual Meeting, the works will be awarded, according to the category in which the work has been submitted.

**XIV. Publication of posters and videos:** The winning posters and videos will be published on the ASADIP website in a space provided for this purpose.

**XV. Certification:** the corresponding certificates will be issued to indicate the participation in this Call for all those authors whose works have been admitted.
