This year, ASADIP is organising the Conference in conjunction with the Organisation of American States, on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the Inter-American Conference on Private International Law and the OAS Course on International Law. On 7 and 8 August, the activities of the Conference will take place at the headquarters of the Rio de Janeiro State School of Magistrates (EMERJ), located at <u>Rua Dom Manuel, No. 25, in the city centre</u>. On 9 August, the activities of the Conference will continue at the Pontificia Universidade Católica do Rio de Janeiro (PUC-Rio), located at <u>Rua Marquês de São Vicente, 225, Gávea</u>, Rio de Janeiro.

The conference will be a space for academic reflection, institutional dialogue and the strengthening of regional and international networks on private international law.
